


Dear Resident of Ambleton,

Wilco Contractors, on behalf of Qualico Communities, will be starting a residential boulevard tree planting program the week of July 15, 2024. This should take 1-2 weeks to complete. During this time, labourers and equipment will be planting trees within the road right of way in front of your home.

These trees will be planted in accordance with the Community Planting Plan, which was approved by the City of Calgary before development began. Tree locations and species are determined and approved by the City of Calgary, based on the available growing space and to avoid conflicts with utilities. **These trees are not optional and are planted within City of Calgary property.**

Although these trees are owned by the City, homeowners are required to water them. The following actions on trees are prohibited: cutting, removing, moving, pruning, penetrating bark, attaching any object, planting additional trees, and spraying trees with any substance other than water.

Please see below for boulevard trees in a typical standard road cross section. This is for illustration purposes only, as some boulevards may look different than the image below.
