Qualico Communities Calgary is happy to share updates on progress for the community of Ambleton. Please use the map located on the following page as a reference for phase numbers corresponding to the notes below.

1. Final acceptance construction in phase 1 was completed in 2024 and has now been handed over to the City of Calgary for maintenance and snow removal responsibilities.
2. Final acceptance construction in phase 2 was completed in 2024 and has now been handed over to the City of Calgary for maintenance and snow removal responsibilities.
3. Final acceptance construction in phase 3 was completed in 2024 and has now been handed over to the City of Calgary for maintenance and snow removal responsibilities.
4. Development construction in phase 4 is complete.
 - Final acceptance maintenance started in 2025 and will resume in the spring of 2026.
 - Landscaping and boulevard tree plantings started in 2025 and will be ongoing subject to buildout. For information about boulevard trees, please see our [blog](#).
 - The developer will continue to maintain this phase until its turned over to the City next year.
5. All major phase 5 development construction is complete with active home construction ongoing.
 - This will continue to be a busy phase in the coming year for home builder construction.
 - Final maintenance will be completed in the 2026 construction season.
 - Landscaping and boulevard tree plantings started in 2025 and will be ongoing subject to buildout.
 - The developer will maintain this phase until it is turned over to the City of Calgary. This phase is anticipated to be turned over in 2026.
6. All major phase 6 development construction is completed with active home construction continuing into the 2026 construction season.
 - This will continue to be a busy area in the coming year for home builder construction.
 - Landscaping and boulevard tree plantings started in the 2025 construction season and will be ongoing subject to buildout.
 - The developer will maintain this phase until it is turned over to the City of Calgary. This phase is anticipated to be turned over in 2026.

7. Phase 7 development construction was completed in the 2025 construction season.
 - This is our final phase of residential construction in the community of Ambleton.
 - This phase includes Front Attached Garage and Laned Homes. The builders for this phase are Shane Homes, Jayman Homes, Broadview Homes, Sterling Homes, and Trico Homes.
 - This will be a busy phase in the coming year for builder home construction.
 - A small park called a municipal reserve (MR) is planned for this phase, which will include enhanced landscaping features, park seating, and picnic areas. This phase will also be tied into an existing environmental reserve (ER) that runs through the community. Construction of the MR site will be completed in 2026. This area is marked on the below map with a star.
 - This phase includes a Catholic school site. The timing of construction is at the discretion of the province. Landscaping for this site is substantially completed. The baseball diamond will open in 2027.

12. Phase 5 park space and pathway snow removal.
